The meeting of the Town Board was called to order at 7:00p.m. Present, Marty Kutsenkow Jim Kiger, David Moody, Cindy Williams, Rodney, Kevin, Mallory Redlin, Don Moyars.

Financials: Kutsenkow made motion to accept, Moody seconded. Voted and approved

Minuets: Meeting minuets Kiger made motion to accept Moody seconded. Voted and approved

Soil & Water Conservation Letter: A letter stating the Town approves of the Big Shawnee Creek project presented to Council in the May 2024 meeting. Moody made a motion to sign the approval letter Kiger seconded, voted and approved.

Tru Flex tax abetment: Submitted to council the CF1's for personal property and real estate for 2025. Kutsenkow made a motion to approve Kiger seconded, voted and approved.

Drain on Northwest St: Rodney explained the ditch in front of Hallet-King resident needs to be addressed. Approximately 20 sections of 24" tile need to be installed through the driveway in order to carry away the water the currently floods the dich. Cost will be around \$4,500.00 for the tile and town employees can do the work. Gretchen Hallett-King appeared and showed pictures to the Council of how it floods every time it rains. Kutsenkow made a motion to approve the work Kiger seconded, voted and approved.


Disconnect: Total of 6, Kutsenkow made motion to proceed with them moody seconded. Voted and approved.


