

TOWN OF WEST LEBANON- TOWN BOARD MEETING- May 9,2022

The regular meeting of the Town Board was called to order at 7:00p.m. Present, Marty Kutsenkow, David Moody, Jim Kiger, Kevin Hawk, Rodney Hawk, Cindy Williams and Mallory Redlin.

Financial Report- Kiger motioned to approve, Moody second voted and approved.

Minutes- Regular meeting Moody motioned to approve, Kiger second voted and approved

Heather Hanley- Just wanted to inform the community of a Community Garden the Nazarene Church is planning behind the Church and explained that individuals could have their own plots or help with the large garden. They are also planning to hold a Farmers Market in the Churches' parking lot.

Community Crossing Grant- The Town has been awarded another grant in the amount of \$79,244.00 at 75-25% match. INDOT has dropped two of the streets we planned to do bringing the amount with our match to \$115,550.25. The bid to finish what needed to be done was for \$143,480.00 which the Council decided to do and cover the difference through the MVH funds.

Moody made the motion to except the bid of \$143480.00 and pay for the two streets ourself, Kiger seconded, voted and approved.

Unsafe Buildings- Mr. Land nor Mr. Pitcock appeared the Council decided to place them both along with TJ Johnson on the unsafe building list and schedule the hearings for the June and July meetings. Kutsenkow made the motion to move all three to the USB list Kiger seconded, voted and approved.

Leary Construction- not on agenda added at meeting, they are working on the water tower doing repairs and found a steel line that drains the tower to be faulty and needs to be replace. The bid was for \$4,660.00 to do and can be completed with the rest of the work, and will also be included in the 10-year militance plan. Kutsenkow made the motion Kiger seconded, voted and approved.



Disconnects- We had a total of 3 for the month. Kiger made a motion to disconnect the 3 on Wednesday morning Moody seconded voted and approved.
