

TOWN OF WEST LEBANON- TOWN BOARD MEETING-May 8 ,2023

The meeting of the Town Board was called to order at 7:00p.m. Present, Marty Kutsenkow, Jim Kiger, David Moody, Cindy Williams, Rodney, Kevin Hawk and Ingrid Barce.

Financials: Moody made motion to accept, Kiger seconded. Voted and approved

Minuets: Meeting minuets from April 10th Kutsenkow made motion to accept Kiger seconded. Voted and approved

Minuets from April 25th Kutsenkow motioned to accept Kiger seconded. Voted and approved.

Conrad/ stop signs: Ms. Conrad asked to have a 3 way stop sign placed on Warren St. to help slow down speeders. Council advised that there is one on 6th and on 3rd Streets both within 100 feet from this section. Kutsenkow suggested that we place the speed sign there to try and slow drivers down before going to the expense of the signs.

Christmas Décor Contract: The new contract will be for 15 lights at a cost of \$2,295 a year for the next three years. Moody objects to doing this, Kiger suggested we look into buying our own. Kutsenkow motioned to accept the contract Kiger seconded. Voted 2-1 approved.

Community Crossings Grant: The Town has been awarded \$74,709.90 to have several sections of roads repaved with the Town having a 25% match. Kutsenkow motioned to approve the 25% match of funds Moody seconded voted and approved.

USDA Loan: We are still approved for the \$3,245,400.00 and Ocra is looking into finding grants to cover the \$700,000.00 match we would need to go forward with the Waste Water Treatment Project. Resolution 5-8-2023 to apply for the loan was presented for Kutsenkow to sign all documentation to go forward with it. Kutsenkow made a motion to accept Moody seconded. Voted and approved.

No conflict of interest paper work were presented for all council members to sign Moody motion to approve Kutsenkow seconded. Voted and approved.

Certification of Officers Documentation: Kutsenkow motion to approve Kiger seconded. Voted and approved.




Disconnect: Total of 9 for May. Kutsenkow made motion to proceed with them Kiger seconded. Voted and approved.
