Financials: Moody made motion to accept, Kiger seconded. Voted and approved

Opioid Settlement: Clerk explained the funds are restricted to a very limited aera for use and that the Town has none of the programs, and that following the lead of other Towns would like to donate to the EMS and/or Police department to use for PPE and/or NARCAN. Council asked to check with those department heads and have attorneys to draft an ordinance for the August 2023 meeting.


Street lights: Clerk presented several options for solar base LED Street lights for the downtown aera, to buy with this years budget to be installed after the State Highway Dept. Redoes High Street and installs handicap sidewalk curbs. Council asked to see how this would affect the warranty and tabled until August 2023 meeting. Marty asked what the Council thought about getting a sign for the Community Room, they agreed it was worth looking into and asked the Clerk to get bids for the next meeting also.

Disconnect: Total of 8 for July. Kutsenkow made motion to proceed with them Kiger seconded. Voted and approved.

Meeting was now open to the public for comments Phil Astell wanted to address Maple Street again, would like for the Town to make a gravel street up to the closed section. Stated the property owners are willing to clean out the trees. Council told him to put a plan in righting for them to look at before they would consider expending the funds to do so.


TOWN OF WEST LEBANON- SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING-JULY 6 ,2023
